1. Date: Saturday, December 22nd, 1:00-4:30pm.
2. Place: Ikebukuro Campus, Rikkyo University
3. Topic: Japan should significantly relax its immigration policies.
(Note: the exact wording is subject to change.)
4. Eligibility: All CIC & COB students are welcome to participate.
5. Team size: Between 2 and 4 students (i.e., two-person, three-person, and four-person teams are eligible.)
6. Registration: To register, submit the entry form to the CIC Office (M606 McKim Hall) or e-mail your names, student IDs, and e-mail addresses to ibunkagakubu@rikkyo.ac.jp no later than 5pm on Friday, November 9th.
7. Rounds: 2 preliminary rounds and a final round
8. Training Sessions: We will hold 3 training sessions from mid-November to early December to ensure that all participants will be well prepared for the competition.
9. Language: English

10. Award: The winning team will receive a 30,000-yen book coupon.
